






Rigid Solid Rubrails




Uniflex Rubrails®



Toe & Spray Rails


Toe Rails and Spray Rails are most often used on commercial boats and are produced in a rigid material. Toe Rails are installed on the deck of the boat adjacent to the rubrail. Spray rails are mounted on the side of the hull to not only keep the boat dry but also can act as a lifting strake in promoting quicker planing and fuel savings.







CAPECR-2 Dimensions are INTERIOR Dimensions




